

Media Release: Response to Provincial Suicide Intervention Funding Announcement

September 22, 2022 - Today, Sheila Malcolmson, BC's Minister of Mental Health and Addictions, announced an <u>investment of \$2 million</u> to support an initiative that will create province-wide standards and training to improve care in the health-care system for people who may be suicidal.

Crisis lines in BC have been leaders across North America in developing and delivering these standards for over fifty years. We look forward to working with the Province and other agencies to create a better mental health crisis care continuum for all British Columbians.

"Today's announcement is a clear and positive indication of the Provinces commitment to mental health crisis care and creating suicide safer communities in BC. The BC Crisis Line Network has been meeting with all levels of government and other frontline agencies to create a continuum of care with crisis phone lines as the key frontline support to decrease pressure on 9-1-1, police, ambulance and emergency rooms," says Stacy Ashton, Chair of the BC Crisis Line Network.

The Network comprises ten regional crisis centres across BC, collectively answering 1800SUICIDE (1-800-784-2433) and 310Mental Health Support (310-6789). The Network operates 24 hours a day, seven days a week and provides lifesaving crisis intervention, suicide risk assessment, and strengths-based collaborative safety planning and follow-up to vulnerable British Columbians.

Network members also provide evidence-based, trauma-informed programs for the public and professionals that increase awareness about suicide, strengthen intervention skills, and facilitate growth and recovery after a suicide experience.
